



Today EU is a net importer of agricultural products


Aggregated agricultural self-sufficiency of the European Union

R&D intense industry but its investment is flowing out of Europe












The EU must boost agricultural competitiveness and productivity in a sustainable way

Health: safeguard the health of farmers and the public by introducing innovative technologies and promoting safe-use



Biodiversity: enhance biodiversity and natural habitats in farming landscapes



Water: protect water resources by introducing innovative solutions and promoting sustainable practices



Food: contribute to a healthy, high quality, affordable food supply for all



Health: Safe and Sustainable Use Initiative (SUI)

- Protect farmer health, encourage good practices
 - Current status: SUI
 projects in 15 countries,
 with a proven record of
 success
 - Next steps: New initiatives to be launched in 2014, spreading to 22 countries

Supporting sustainable agriculture

- Current status: 57 farms/4
 countries; create indexing tool
 for farmers to improve &
 monitor biodiversity
- Next steps: develop the standards together with stakeholders








Water: TOPPS/Prowadis



Protect water sources

- Current status: more than
 2,000 farmers trained in 16
 countries
- Next steps: 6 pilot catchments identified for rollout









Food: BMP's to manage Residues European



Contribute to safe food

- Current status: programs in Spain, Turkey to reduce residues, encourage good agricultural practices
- Next steps: training programs in Turkey


